Which venues are ideal for the 811 VR Experience?

- Trade shows
- Home and garden shows
- Training/education events
- Sporting events (ideally under concourses, shielded from weather)

What size area will I need for my 811 VR Experience event?

• The 811 VR Experience is built to ideally work in a 10' X 10' space.

Do I need to provide any equipment to ensure the VR works as intended?

• The 811 VR Experience needs a 32"- 40" TV for use, which is NOT provided by CGA.

Can I use it at outdoor events?

- The 811 VR Experience was designed for use indoors, which is CGA's preferred type of venue.
- Outdoor use will be approved on a case-by-case basis based on access to power, Internet and a four-sided tent.

How much staff will I need to run the 811 VR Experience?

- CGA recommends having two or three people on hand for set up, execution and tear down of the 811 VR Experience.
- Three-person set up:
 - Person #1 welcomes users and explains technology/the experience
 - Person #2 oversees technology (placing mask/headphones on user)
 - Person #3 oversees tablet
- Two-person set up:
 - Person #1 welcomes users and explains technology/the experience
 - Person #2 oversees technology (placing mask/headphones on user) and oversees tablet

How much does the equipment weigh?

- The equipment weighs about 75 pounds in total, with the largest box weighing 50 pounds.
- You will want to use a van or SUV to transport the 811 VR Experience.

For how many days can I use the 811 VR Experience?
